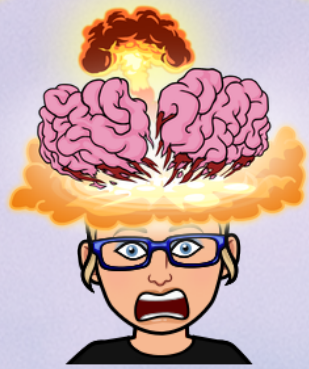

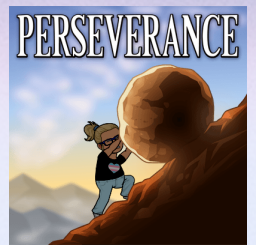

This is an example of humour. It was really validating to see that humour is useful in an approach to managing the online environment. I'm hilarious.



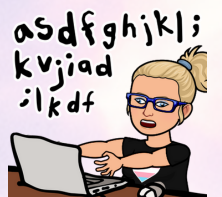
